White Wines

Country Glass Bottle

PETIRROJO CHARDONNAY Chile 7.25 26.00

Fruity aromas of ripe apricot and lush pineapple. On the palate you get subtle white flowers and green apple which add complexity to the wine.

REALCE SAUVIGNON BLANC Spain 7.25 26.00

The sun adds tropical notes that complement the citrus lemon and lime of the Sauvignon Blanc. Medium bodied and full of life.

GIULIANA GARENEGA PINOT GRIGIO Italy 7.25 26.00

A benchmark Pinot Grigio, with delicate hints of rose petal aromas on the nose, cool climate orchard fruit flavours, but with ripeness balancing a crisp acidity and persistent length.

FOURNIER SAUVIGNON BLANC France 33.00

Pronounced aromas of exotic fruits like citrus and peach with hints of floral notes. Fresh and fruity on the palate with a crisp lingering finish.

ARALDICA TRADIZIONE GAVI Italy 34.00

Abundance of zesty fruits with hints of apple and pear on the nose. Fresh and steely on the palate with crisp minerality balanced by notes of melon and stone fruits on the finish.

TEN ROCKS SAUVIGNON BLANC NZ 34.00

Fresh cut grass, passionfruit and citrus. The palate has fresh acidity, great concentration and lovely length. Bold flavours of gooseberry and freshly cut herbs are nicely matched by underlying minerality.

PICPOUL DE PINET SAINT PEYRE France 35.00

Crystal clear with green highlights, though can be more golden from older vines, soft, delicate nose, with pleasant hints of acacia and hawthorn blossom. Delicate and fresh in the mouth it has an excellent acid/structure balance.

VINA SOBREIRA ALBARINO RIAS BAIXAS Spain 35.00

Lemon with with greenish hints. Intense nose with fruits and white flowers with light touches of green apple and citrus. On the palate, there are again white flowers and a good expression of the varietal, rounded, fleshy, with structure and good acidity, providing freshness and durability. Bright with green reflections, banana aromas with hints of pineapple and lemon. Round and lively.

LES HAUTS DE MONTERALS CHARDONNAY France 38.00

Fresh cut grass, passionfruit and citrus. The palate has fresh acidity, great concentration and lovely length. Bold flavours of gooseberry and freshly cut herbs are nicely matched by underlying minerality.

Flavours of fresh red fruits, along with notes of raspberries are complemented by a bright mouth watering acidity and a crisp vibrant finish.



Country Glass PETIRROJO MERLOT

Chile 7.25 26.00

Fruity aromas, dominated by red cherries and lush raspberries with a subtle hint of toffee. On the palate the wine is juicy and elegant with well balanced and rounded tannins.

FLORES DE CATALINA **CABERNET SAUVIGNON**

Spain 7.25

An easy drinking Cabernet Sauvignon with blackberry, plum and blackcurrant on the nose and a full rounded palate.

PAULITTA WINEMAKERS SEL. MALBEC Argentina 7.25 26.00

Savoury aromas along with delicious berry notes. Balanced by lovely acidity and gentle tannins with a pleasant finish.

TABLE MOUNTAIN SHIRAZ South Africa 7.25

Dark ruby in colour. Aromas of ripe plums, berries and oak spices with a hint of cigar box. Medium-bodied with ripe plums, new leather and a good tannic structure.

LES ESPERONS PINOT NOIR France 32.00

Classic and juicy with flavours of cherry and raspberry and a smooth, velvety palate

FINCA LAS CABRAS TEMPRANILLO RIOJA Spain

Fruity blackcurrant and redcurrant flavours with sweet vanilla and cinnamon spice.

ROSSO VERONESE FALEZZA VOLPOLICELLA Italy

Complex bouquet with scents of plums, blackberries and blueberries with a hint of spice. Full bodied on the palate with a smooth, velvety finish.

DELAS COTE DE RHONE France

Deep colour with plum-like hue. The nose is classical Syrah, with berry fruit, violet, licorice & spices. Full, rounded palate with delicate tannins.

CHATEAU VIEUX LARTIQUE, ST. EMILLION France 42.00

80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc. Savoury cassis and plum fruit blending harmoniously with toasted vanilla and cedarwood.

The story of the North Star Hotel

In the 18th century the area around this hotel was coastline and was popularly known as "The Strand". Before the Custom House could be built, great oak beams had to be laid on the marshy soil to provide foundations. In fact, this area was rural and considered outside the city.

Amiens Street was called after the Viscount Amiens, which was a minor title of the Earl of Aldborough (whose splendid Town House still stands in Portland Row, a short distance from here). The hotel was built early in the 19th century, and pre-dates the Railway Station by several decades. At that time, the "Great North Road", as it could be called, started from here, and, as a consequence, several hotels sprang up in this street alone.

The site where Connolly Station now stands was a pound for stray horses. All travel was by horse and coach, or private carriage, in those days and a large livery stables, at the back of the North Star, gave it a distinct advantage over its rivals.

This was the mid 19th century, and the owner's name was Mr. James Carolin He was a first class hotelier and made his country guests comfortable and happy during their stay in Dublin. The city was making steady recovery from the Famine and new enterprises were springing up: the nearby docks were flourishing and the trains were leaving from across the street.

All this activity brought great business to the hotel. In 1892 a Mr. J.C. Malone bought it, and at once started a major programme of extension, redecoration and modernization. His advertisements tell us, among other things, that

"the most scrupulous and absolute cleanliness is a marked feature in every department of the establishment", who could ask for more!

The Golden age of the railways came and went. Today the car has superseded the train for long journeys (more or less). Still the North Star flourishes. Bedrooms have been built where once stables and carriage houses stood.

Mr. Brian McGettigan is now the Proprietor and a whole new era is opening up for this fine old Hostelry. We do hope that your stay here, however long or short, will be a happy one.
